# FAQ'S General Care

### How many dogs can you board?

I am licensed to take 4 dogs, plus my 3 resident dogs, so 7 all together. This way – and because I am a home boarder with limited space – I can give total care to each dog as though they are part of our extended family.

## Do you board intact males or bitches in season?

The short answer is no, I do not board intact males over 6 months of age, and I cannot take bitches in, or close to season.

### Do you provide meals?

I don't provide meals, but can offer low fat treats free of charge. You MUST supply your own food and preferred treats and inform me of any special instructions or dietary needs (please complete this on our Pawfile form). I always feed dogs under supervision and can separate if required. Iris, Davy & Dolly are fed around 0700h and then again at 1700h, but I am happy to stick to any feeding routines you advise/prefer. I will provide feeding/drinking bowls, unless you prefer to provide your own. I always ensure that dogs have easy access to plenty of clean water at all times.

## Do dogs need to be vaccinated?

Absolutely a must! You are responsible for the full and appropriate, up-to-date vaccinations against Canine Distemper, Infectious Canine Hepatitis (Canine Adenovirus) Leptospirosis (Lanicola and Licterohaemorrhagicae), Canine Parvovirus, Kennel Cough and other relevant diseases. The course of vaccination must have been completed at least 4 weeks prior to the date of boarding or in accordance with manufacturer's instructions. (Proof of immunity provided via Titer testing may be accepted in the case of those without full vaccinations).

# What if my dog is unwell and on medication?

If medication is required to be given, this is not a problem as long the medication is in its original container with clear instructions. Pets can only be accepted for boarding when in good health, and you warrant that to the best of your knowledge that your pet is not suffering from or carrying any infectious or contagious disease and has not been in contact with any such disease within the last 30 days.
